

College Level Examination Program (CLEP) The College awards credit for satisfactory scores on many of the Subject Examinations offered through the CLEP program. Only freshman and sophomore students are eligible to take CLEP exams without prior permission from a department chair or school registrar. Juniors and students who have attained senior standing may attempt CLEP exams, but first must obtain written permission from the department chair and registrar of the college discipline in which a particular exam is offered. **The following chart lists scores required for credit in the CLEP Program.
