Florence-Darlington Technical College understands the importance of securing work-ready employees for entry-level positions in the workforce.

The ability to assess good work ethic and basic industryspecific skills, **before making an investment in a new employee**, can impact a company's bottom line significantly.

Through its **Employment Readiness Services**, the Corporate & Workforce Development division of FDTC provides training for entry-level employees that will create and sustain an ongoing pool of prospective candidates for area manufacturing and industry.

FDTC's employment readiness programs allow business and industry to assess potential candidates for entry-level positions before they are hired and extend job offers with the assurance that prospective employees have acquired skills and knowledge defined by the company.

We work with you to define curricula and required skills for jobs, schedule the training, and provide staff and equipment for delivery of instruction. Training can be delivered on-site at your facility or at any FDTC campus.

#### ADMINISTRATIVE MEDICAL ASSISTANT (AMA) HYBRID COURSE

This course prepares students for a career as an Administrative Medical Assistant, focusing on front-office operations in healthcare settings. Students will develop skills in patient scheduling, medical billing and coding, insurance processing, and electronic health records (EHR) management. Emphasis is placed on HIPAA compliance, professionalism, communication, and problem-solving in a fast-paced medical environment. Through hands-on practice and assessments, students will gain proficiency in medical office software and administrative procedures. Upon completion, students will be prepared to take the NHA Certified Medical Administrative Assistant (CMAA) exam and pursue careers in medical offices, hospitals, and outpatient facilities.

#### **CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT (CNA)**

The Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) course is designed to equip participants with the foundational knowledge and practical skills necessary to provide basic patient care under the supervision of licensed nursing professionals. Instruction is delivered through a combination of classroom lectures, simulated laboratory experiences, and direct clinical practice in an accredited skilled nursing setting. The curriculum covers essential concepts related to nursing care for elderly and chronically ill adult populations, with a focus on effective communication, patient safety, and core responsibilities involved in providing quality care. Upon successful completion, students will be eligible to take the SC Nurse Aide Exam to obtain certification.

#### **EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN (EMT)**

Upon completion, graduates are qualified to provide essential care in various emergency scenarios and are often employed by ambulance services, fire departments, or hospitals. #### **EKG TECHNICIAN**

This program is designed to provide students with the knowledge and skills necessary to accurately obtain and analyze EKGs. The course covers the anatomy and physiology of the heart, the electrical conduction system, and the principles behind EKG monitoring. Students will learn to identify normal and abnormal heart rhythms, recognize life-threatening arrhythmias, detect signs of cardiac ischemia, and understand symptoms of cardiac compromise. Emphasis is placed on appropriate responses to abnormal and critical EKG findings. Upon successful completion, students will be eligible to sit for the EKG Technician Certification exam offered by the National Healthcareer Association (NHA).

#### STERILE PROCESSING TECHNICIAN

The curriculum includes instruction on operating sterilization units and monitoring sterilization effectiveness. Through a combination of classroom learning and hands-on clinical experience, students will be prepared to take the Sterile Processing and Distribution Technician

Certification Exam and begin a career in sterile processing.

This course introduces the Gas Metal Arc (MIG) welding process using a hardwire. The course covers safety, equipment, and skills used in MIG welding. Students will use a MIG welder to perform the basic positions of a lab, tee, v-groove style joints in various positions.

#### **GMAW (MIG) FLUX-CORE WELDING**

#### **GTAW (TIG) WELDING**

In this course, students gain basic TIG welding skills and learn about welding safety and equipment. Upon successful completion, students will be able to produce fillet welds to visual criteria, in several positions. This course will expand the knowledge gained in basic TIG welding concepts, and provide more advanced instruction in TIG welding applications. Upon successful completion, students will be able to produce open butt welds made to visual criteria, including pipe.

#### **PIPE WELDING**

To qualify you must pass a 3/8" plate vertical weld test. Students will learn how to TIG weld carbon steel pipe and stick weld carbon pipe in 2G,5G and 6G positions. This course prepares students to work in the industry as an entry level pipe welder. Successful graduates can expect to find employment with mechanical and industrial contractors.

#### **SMAW (STICK) WELDING**

This course introduces the Shielded Metal Arc (Stick) welding process. The course covers the safety, equipment, and skills used in Stick welding. Emphasis is placed on padding, fillet, and groove welds in various positions with SMAW electrodes. Upon completion, students should be able to perform SMAW fillet and groove welds on carbon plate with prescribed electrodes. Students will also learn to set up equipment and proper electrode selection.



Requests for refunds must be made directly to the Continuing Education Office by telephone or in person. Automatic refunds will be processed on courses canceled by the College.

Requests for refunds will be honored as follows:

- 1. If requested a minimum of 48 hours (2 business days) before the course starts, a full refund, less a \$10 processing fee, will be given.
- 2. If requested less than 48 hours (2 business days) before the course starts, no refund will be given.
- 3. No refunds for program related fees.

#### **TRANSFER FEE**

After registering for your initial section with CWD, if you decide to transfer to a different section or new course, there will be a **\$10 processing fee** for each transfer.

#### **CWD SCWINS FUNDING POLICIES**

No Shows:

- Students who do not attend the scheduled class that they registered for using SCWINS funding, will be ineligible to register for another class with SCWINS funding for a period of one year.
   Unsuccessful Completion of class:
- Students who are unsuccessful (receive "U" grade) in completing the class that was funded by SCWINS will be ineligible to register for another SCWINS funded class for a period of six months.
   Repeat Classes:
- Students who successfully completes a class (receive "S" grade) with SCWINS funding cannot retake the same class at a later time with SCWINS funding.
