



CCAMPIS for FDTC Students

Child Care Access Means Parents in School:

Child care financial assistance for low-income student parents who are enrolled in credit hours in a degree study, certificate program who is eligible for a Pell Grant at Florence-Darlington Technical College (FDTC)

CCAMPIS supports care in campus affiliated child care centers. Campus space and funding are limited; child care is provided based on availability.

CCAMPIS PROGRAM

The goal of CCAMPIS is to assist low-income students who are a new student or enrolled student at FDTC with child care expenses so they could persist and graduate. The CCAMPIS program provides childcare funding to achieve grant outcomes emphasizing student parent enrollment, persistence and graduation. We encourage CCAMPIS students to understand these outcome goals. CCAMPIS is a 4-year federal grant through the US Department of Education, but is always dependent on funds available from the Department of Education at the federal level Eligibility Requirements:

- Students must apply for financial aid as eligibility factors (Pell recipient or Pell eligible) are determined from your financial aid application (FAFSA). Please contact the Director of CCAMPIS for any questions at 843-413-2706.
- Students must participate which is eligible for the Pell Grant.
- This grant helps students to complete their degrees in a timely fashion and obtain employment that can support their family.
- Funding is granted to those students with a child/child who ages are from infants through 12 years of age.

Program Requirements:

- All student parents must be enrolled throughout the entire semester in order to continue to qualify for childcare benefits.
- Volunteer in the child/children daycare or after school program three hours a semester to promote the importance of education and support from the family.
- Maintain a 2.0 GPA and be enrolled as a part-time or full-time student for the duration of the semester.
- Student Parents must attend two mandatory workshops per semester.
- Parents must attend the annual CCAMPIS Orientation and a 1 on 1 meeting with the director of CCAMPIS...
- Parents must complete an annual evaluation of their program, care and personal experience with CCAMPIS to receive ongoing funding.
- Student parents who graduate are required to complete a post-graduation survey on their enrollment, ability to persist in studies and employability outcomes with CCAMPIS

support.

- Student parents who are unable to meet these program requirements will be ineligible for CCAMPIS funding.
- Students could not only take online courses; the majority of the courses should be on campus.
- Student could not have all online courses must have campus classes as well!
- Student must provide the Director of CCAMPIS with a copy of their class schedule every semester.

I agree to participate in ongoing and/or post -graduate surveys conducted by the CCAMPIS Director pertaining to program evaluation including but not limited to my employment, income, and quality of care/services.

_____ I understand that aggregate information, but no personal information, will be shared with the Department of Higher Education in Washington DC, who funds this program.

_____ I give my permission for the CAMPIS Director to communicate with FDTC Financial Aid and/or my child care provider(s) regarding any of my financial, or information related to the care of my child/children.

_____ I understand that FDTC will not be held responsible for anything that occurs at a Daycare or an Afterschool program. The Daycare or afterschool I have selected for my child.

_____ I understand I could not take all online courses. The majority of my courses must be on campus.

_____ I understand that I will be responsible for the two weeks' notice, if I withdraw

my child/children out of the daycare or afterschool program.

Receipt of the above information completes the application process. Sorry, incomplete applications will not be placed on the waitlist for placement and funding.

My signature on this application indicates my willingness to fully participate in the CCAMPIS Program. I agree to comply with all program requirements. I understand that If I do not meet all the program requirements by the given due dates, I will NOT receive CCAMPIS funds and will pay my child care center my balance due. I further agree to contact the Office of Child Care and Family Resources if my status as a student change, either fiscally or academically.
